

## **Ride for the Arts FAQ**

### **Q: Date, place, and time of the Ride?**

A: The Ride will be held on Sunday, June 3 from 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. at the Summerfest Grounds (100 N. Harbor Drive. Milwaukee, WI 53202 South Gate Entrance). This event is held rain or shine!

### **Q: What are the routes?**

A: There are five routes: 5-, 12-, 25-, 45-, and the 70-mile

### **Q: How do I register?**

A: Visit [www.upafride.org](http://www.upafride.org) for registration! Keep in mind, registrations are not refundable!

### **Q: How do I volunteer?**

### **Q: What does my registration fee cover?**

A: The registration fee covers costs for putting on the Ride for the Arts. These fees, in addition to Ride pledges, go directly towards helping UPAF reach our fundraising goal for the performing arts in our community.

### **Q: How does it work with “Kids 12 and Under Ride free?”**

A: Thanks to the Milwaukee Brewers Community Foundation, kids 12 and under ride free when accompanied by one registered adult. Once you click on “Youth (12 and under)” follow the prompts to register including selecting a bike route. **Please note:** You may use the accompanying adult’s email address on the registration page should you not want to include the child’s personal email.

### **Q: How do I get my registration packet?**

A: To control printing and shipping costs and to pass those savings on to you, we keep each rider registration packet in advance of the event. This includes your bib, your map of the event and any additional information required. T-shirts and bulkier items will be available for pickup one and two days before the Ride at the Italian Community Center.

### **Q: What is the Finish Line Party?**

A: The Finish Line Party is a post Ride celebration for all riders and their families and friends. A new enhanced party will feature more entertainment for adults as well as fun activities for the kids.
