NORTH SHORE COUNTRY CLUB AND UPAF COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES

In an effort to keep outing participants, North Shore Country Club and UPAF employees and volunteers safe, the following procedures have been implemented in response to COVID-19.

GENERAL GUIDELINES AND RULES

- All participants, guests and volunteers are encouraged to wear a face mask or other covering; however, this is not required.
- All participants, guests and volunteers should adhere to six-foot social distancing. Please avoid gathering in large groups of over eight people.
- To play the contests and purchase mulligans, individuals will need to use credit cards — **if cash is used, change will not be made.**
- Disinfecting/sanitation and sanitizer/wipe stations are located outside the clubhouse.
- All physical contact will be prohibited including, but not limited to, handshakes, high fives and fist bumps.
- No reusable cups should be brought to the outing. If a person does bring a reusable cup, their drink will be made in a disposable cup and the person may transfer the drink to their reusable cup — no drinks will be made in reusable cups.
- There is no bag drop — every golfer must place their bag on their own cart.
- Golfers can choose to ride carts as a single or duo.
 - No signage or decorating on golf carts will be allowed.
- Cups on each green have been modified so no flags need to be removed when in play.
- Water stations along the course have been removed. Water and other beverages will be available at drink carts and the outdoor bar.
- All portable restrooms have been removed from the course. Stationary restrooms are available, including NSCC clubhouse restrooms (in the 28th Hole ONLY — the remainder of the clubhouse will be closed to guests).
 - The indoor restrooms at the turn are also the club member locker rooms, so please be respectful of other people’s property.
- The upstairs patio — though outdoors — is closed.
- The practice putting green is available for use 1.5 hours prior to outing start.
- The short game facility and driving range will NOT be available to participants.

- The after-golf cocktail-only reception will take place on the driving range with a tent and cocktail tables. No seating is allowed.
- Dinner box to go must be eaten off site — in car or taken home.

CLEANING AND STAFF PPE & SAFETY PROTOCOL

- Cleaning and disinfecting of frequently touched surfaces will occur hourly and will occur for shared objects each time they are used. North Shore Country Club has taken many steps and precautions to keep staff and visitors to the club safe.
- All North Shore Country Club employees wear masks. All food and beverage service employees will always wear masks and gloves.
- First aid staff have proper personal protective equipment to wear in first aid and rescues.
- Staff will follow CDC guidelines. Those exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, those who test positive or those have been in contact with someone symptomatic or that tested positive will not be allowed to work until NSCC receives a negative test result
 - If a symptomatic employee or an employee tests positive for COVID-19 and that employee has been onsite within 72 hours of symptoms or a positive test, all employees that were in contact with such employee are required to self-quarantine. The self-quarantine will remain in place for 14 days or until the symptomatic employee receives a negative COVID-19 test or the infected employee receives a negative test result.

COVID-19 CANCELLATION CONTINGENCY PLANS

- If COVID-19 prevents the UPAF golf outing from being held, UPAF will schedule a new date.
- If COVID-19 prevents the UPAF golf outing from being held and the change is announced within 10 days prior to the event, all participants will receive a foursome voucher for a future date of their choice.
