UPAF PRESIDENT AND CEO



The United Performing Arts Fund (UPAF) is proud to have raised \$12,073,795 through our 2018 Campaign. This achievement is due in large part to the determination, dedication and drive of our Campaign Co-Chairs, Board of Directors, Campaign Cabinet, Workplace Giving Ambassadors, Member Groups, Volunteer Solicitors and staff. Thanks to your support, we allocated \$9,045,000 to ensure entertainment excellence in Southeastern Wisconsin. UPAF's 14 Member Groups received a total of \$8,885,085 with the additional funds directed to smaller performing arts organizations through UPAF's Affiliate Program. My heartfelt thanks to our donors, sponsors and volunteers for allowing UPAF to enhance Southeastern Wisconsin's cultural, economic and educational vitality.

Several factors contributed to the success of the 2018 Campaign, including:

- Workplace Giving Campaigns raised \$454,261 in new money, a 2.3% increase from 2017.
- UPAF Bright Minds, sponsored by BMO Harris Bank, hit an all-time high with 11 Member Groups receiving a total of \$673,500, a \$73,500 increase over 2017, for arts education programming. Most of those dollars came from UPAF Notable Women, also sponsored by BMO Harris Bank, which raised \$78,000 in new money.
- Adopt an Artist, sponsored by Husch Blackwell, a program that connects companies with local talent, almost tripled in funding, bringing in \$57,000 from 114 small-to-mid-sized companies.
- Reinhart Attorneys at Law Final Stretch Match helped raise \$73,583.
- UPAF Connect, presented by Brico Fund, a community outreach program, brought in \$240,500. This program takes the arts into the neighborhoods while also bringing the neighborhoods to the arts. UPAF is partnering with 21 nonprofit organizations to ensure everyone in our community has the opportunity to enjoy the best in music, dance and theater.
- UPAF Dancing on the Green Golf Outing, presented by Associated Bank and chaired by Jim Mueller of Mueller QAAS, raised a record \$67,000.
- Next Generation UPAF, sponsored by We Energies Foundation, raised \$54,000 in new money bringing more than 120 new emerging leaders into the organization.

I would like to extend a sincere thank you to our three exceptional 2018 Co-Chairs – Jim Borris, president and CEO of Zilber Ltd., Susan Martin, retired executive vice president of WEC Energy Group and Dave Vetta, Milwaukee region advisory board chair at First Business Bank. Their tenacity, creativity, connections and business acumen were invaluable assets to our overall success.

On behalf of UPAF and the organizations we fund, thank you for believing in our mission to make a vibrant performing arts scene possible in the Greater Milwaukee area.
