

MUSIC: ATTENTIVE

Latino Arts Strings Program (LASP) Ensembles

can provide one of several ensembles for Workplace Giving Campaigns. LASP is led by Program Director Dinorah Marquez and supported by several musicians and instructors featuring violin, viola, cello, bass and guitar. LASP Ensembles range in group size from 8 to 40 and musical offerings vary depending on your event.

LASP Mariachi Juvenil (H.S.)

A 25-member string ensemble that performs a wide array of Latin Marican concert and folk music, ranging from Mariachi to Tango, from Moncayo to Piazzola. 45-60 min. Can only do evening or weekend performances.

• LASP Mariachi Infantil (M.S.)

A 40-member string ensemble that performs mostly Mexican and Puerto Rican folk and concert music. 30-45 min. Can only do brief lunch time performances, or performances after 3:15 p.m.

LASP Cello Choir (M.S. & H.S.)

A 12-member cello ensemble that performs primarily European classical music. 10-15 min. M.S. ensemble can only do brief lunch time performances, or performances after 3:15 p.m. Including H.S. performances must be in the evening or weekends.



LASP Guitar Chamber Orchestra (H.S.)

A 7-member classical guitar ensemble that performs Latin American and European classical music. 15-25 min. Can only do evening or weekend performances.

LENGTH: 10-60 minutes, depending on program requirements

AUDIENCE SIZE: 20+

REQUIREMENTS: Depending on ensemble may require a sound system and large space or stage; armless chairs for cellos and classical quitar performers. Large ensembles require cello chairs as well.

BOOKING TIME: Prefer 4-8 weeks prior to event to plan for transportation

YOUTH PERFORMER RESTRICTIONS: Please have your event at lunch or after 3:30 p.m. to best accommodate school

schedules. Older students are available from 5-7 p.m. weekdays or

some weekends.
